### REGISTRATION AND INFORMATION

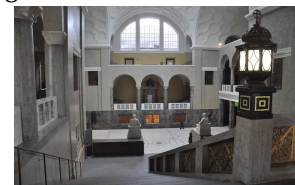
#### Prior to the Conference

You need **to register** for the conference in order to be able to give your presentation. If you haven't registered by now, please do so as soon as possible via our conference website ([www.acpel2015.org](http://www.acpel2015.org)).

#### During the conference

Please **check in** at the registration desk (in Lichthof) and address the staff there if you have any questions regarding your presentation. The registration will be open during the following times:

### PRESENTATION DETAILS

Please prepare your presentation slides in the standard PowerPoint format (4:3) and save it as .ptx or .ppt file. Please use text parsimoniously, make sure that any text is written in a font that is large enough to be clearly readable in conference rooms, and give your contact information on the last slide.

We advise you to send your files to us ahead of time so that we can check whether they operate well and upload them onto the respective computer. Please send them to **presentations@acpel2015.org** no later than **Sep 6, 2015, 12 pm** (Central European Summer Time, CEST). We kindly ask you to also bring your presentation file on a **USB flash drive** (thumb drive) to the conference and come to the room of your session as soon as possible in one of the coffee breaks, the latest **10-15 min before the start of your**

**session.** You will have the possibility to check your pre-sent presentation again or upload your presentation directly onto the computer in the room.

#### **THEMED CONCURRENT SESSION**

You will be presenting a session format called “themed concurrent session” (Thursday, 10 Sep). These sessions are based on submitted abstracts that were selected for oral presentations. We have tried to arrange the presentations under common themes. You will have **10 minutes** for your **presentation** plus **5 minutes** for questions, answers, and comments.

In the interest of your fellow speakers and the audience, please stay within your allotted time. Otherwise, the chairs/moderators will have to step in in order to allow a fair time management.
